ABSTRACT

The churches do, preach and teach about evangelism. However, the churches are not growing and the number of Christian children is decreasing. The church in Thailand has 180 years history in working in evangelism, social work through Christian hospitals, and the founding Christian schools. However, only 0.7% population is Christians. The reason is that Thailand is deeply rooted in Buddhism and the churches in Thailand lack of discipleship training needed to rise up new leaders.

This research proposes an approach to Christian Education and Discipleship for children from 4 to 14 years old in Huai Som Suk village of Thailand. The purpose of this research is to study local children, and find the way to approach children and effectively present the Gospel in order to rise up new leaders.
